Soil disturbing contractors are required to have at least one trained individual on site every day of soil disturbing activity as of May 1, 2010. This DEC mandated four-hour course is designed to inform individuals responsible for installing, construction or maintaining erosion and sediment control practices in areas such as Construction, Grading, Excavating, Filling, Soil Stockpiling, Demolition, Clear-Cutting, Grubbing and Stump Removal. The card is valid for 3-years from the date of the course.

This workshop will be conducted by the OCSWCD with cooperation from the Syracuse Builders Exchange as part of the Storm Water Education program. Pre-Registration with payment is required one week in advance of the course. Each person planning to attend must complete a registration form (web address below) supplied by the NYS DEC and return the original form with payment to SBE. PLEASE NOTE: FAXED OR EMAILED COPIES OF THE FORM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED – ORIGINAL FORMS COMPLETED IN INK ONLY. No walk-in registrations will be accepted. First come-first served for 30 seats. All registrants are required to bring a photo ID with them to the course. This storm water training focuses on providing training required to comply with the contractor's responsibilities under the NYS DEC Construction Activity Permit No: GP-0-08-001.
