



SBE 2009 CRAFTSMANSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM

1. Purpose of the Program

To recognize exceptional craftsmanship and the display of interest and ingenuity in order to encourage the highest grade of workmanship.

2. Extent of the Program

a. Exceptional craftsmanship in the execution of work in the following divisions:

Winners will be recognized by the presentation of awards to the mechanics and employers who executed the work or in the case of more than one mechanic, the mechanic mainly responsible for the excellence of the work as designated by said employer. The awards dinner will be held on June 6, 2008.

- b. Awards will carry the name of the mechanic, the employer, the type of work executed and the project for which the work was executed.
- c. Awarded projects will be considered for prominent inclusion in the 2009 Builders Exchange Buyers Guide and the Syracuse Builders Exchange website.

3. Eligibility

Nominations shall be for any craft or trade performed by a **member firm of the Syracuse Builders Exchange** and their employees. Nominations must be for **work completed from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008 and submitted by May 1, 2009**. The Craftsmanship Awards Committee will review the work in a reasonable period of time following receipt of nominations. **The committee has the right to reject any nomination forms and required materials received later than the May 1, 2009 deadline.**

4. Type of Work Eligible

- a. Nominations will be accepted for craftsmanship exhibited "on the jobsite" and "off the jobsite" such as shop fabrication providing such work becomes a permanent part of a structure (factory production of stock work is not eligible).
- b. Characteristics to be considered: (1) quality and professionalism, (2) craftsmanship, (3) degree of difficulty
- c. Nominations will be accepted for work **in Onondaga and contiguous counties** only.

5. Who May Make Nominations

Nominations may be made by any Syracuse Builders Exchange member by submission of the designated form with photographs to the Syracuse Builders Exchange Office by **May 1, 2009**.
